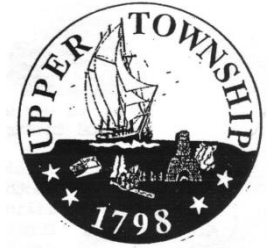

# Strawberry Bread

Makes 2 loaves:

2 (10 ounce) packages frozen strawberries  
thawed

Marj Bixby has the strawberries

4 eggs

1 ¼ cup salad oil

3 cups flour

2 cups sugar

3 teaspoons cinnamon

1 teaspoon baking soda

1 teaspoon salt

1 cup chopped nuts (optional)

1 tbs. lemon juice

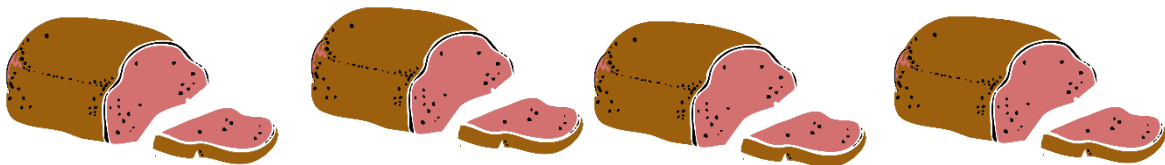
Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Grease and flour three 8x4 loaf pans. Carroll Bailey has the pans.

In a bowl combine strawberries, eggs and oil. In a separate bowl combine flour, sugar, cinnamon, baking soda, and nuts. Add strawberry mixture to dry ingredients and stir until blended.

Pour batter into pans. Bake 1 hour or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean.

Keep the loaves in the pans, wrap them, and bring them to the Gandy Farmstead on the day of the Strawberry Festival

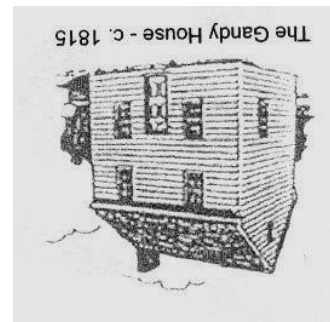
