



### June



- There are no meetings in July.


### August

The months of March, April and May have been eventful. In March we held our first meeting of the year, our annual covered dish supper and show and tell. As usual we had good food and a most interesting time.




The speaker at our April meeting was Tom Champion. He told us all about the Civilian Conservation Corp which not only built Lake Nummy and all the roads and buildings at the Belleplain State Forest, but also the impoundments and roads in the Tuckahoe Fishing and Hunting Preserve.

In May Kim Baker spoke to us about the saving and ongoing restoration of the Ocean City Life Saving Station. These stations protected our coastlines for nearly a century until the service was absorbed by the U.S. Coast Guard after World War I.
