This scholarship is open to a male or female fulltime college students enrolled in a Graduate program who must be residents or dependents of residents who live within the geographical boundaries, which are: To the North, the city limits of Corbin City, To the South, Cedar Swamp Creek, To the East, the intersection of Cedar Swamp Creek & Tuckahoe River if extended, To the West, the Dennis Township – Woodbine border. **THE FOLLOWING MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH THIS APPLICATION:**

- A. Transcript of last semester of college displaying a “B” GPA.
- B. All applicants -A typed, double spaced essay, not more than 500 words, describing why you have chosen your stated career, and the factors that led to this decision. Include an explanation as to why you feel you should be considered for this scholarship and any special circumstances not already named.
- C. All Applicants - A minimum of two personal letters of recommendation from someone other than a relative. (Teacher, Guidance Counselor, Employer, Clergy.) The packet must be sent to the Scholarship Committee, HPSUT, Inc. % Bill Eisele 280 Old Tuckahoe Rd, Petersburg, N.J. 08270.
- D. Applicants will be selected based on a variety of criteria including financial need and individual or family participation as volunteers in all of the HPSUT events. Financial Aid information must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee prior to May 2, 2026. A copy of the financial aid offer from the college and the Expected Family Contribution from the FAFSA must be included. An award of up to \$1,000 is offered to 1 male or 1 female. Final award amount will be determined after reviewing volunteering efforts.
